The Consultant Chest Physicians on the Board of Trustees have asked that we try to raise sufficient monies to provide portable Ultrasound Imaging Equipment for both Cheltenham General and Gloucestershire Royal Hospitals. This equipment will aid the clinicians to find out exactly what's going on inside the chests of their patients. It will also provide a fast accurate means of determining where chest drains should be inserted. Sonosite Ltd, based in Hertfordshire, is the preferred supplier for this equipment





These scanners are very portable allowing the physician to get the information that is needed quickly, accurately and <u>at bedside!</u>. Definitely something our hospitals need.

The two scanners will cost £40,000 and we'd like to provide them to both facilities within 12 months.
